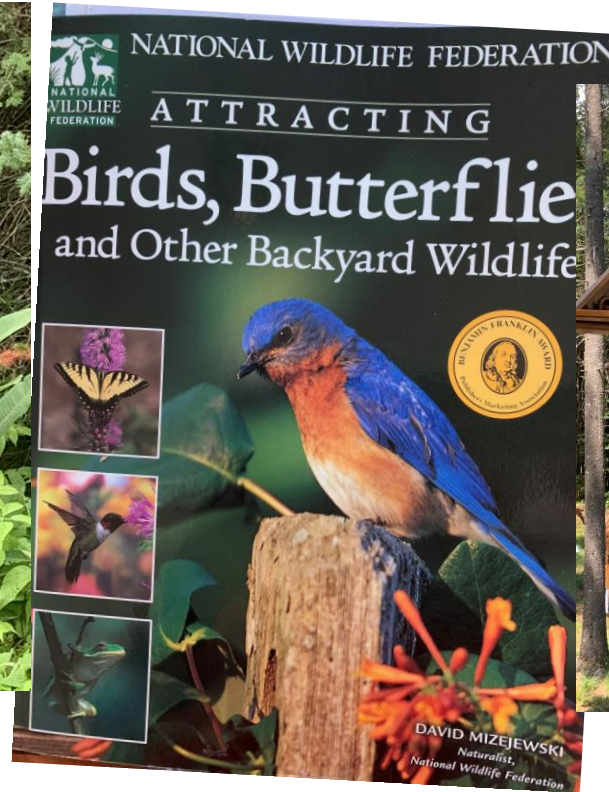

## Youth Programs

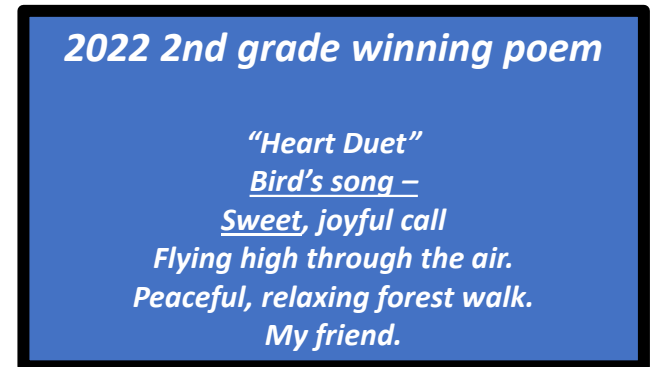

You designate the State or National Forest where the trees will be planted

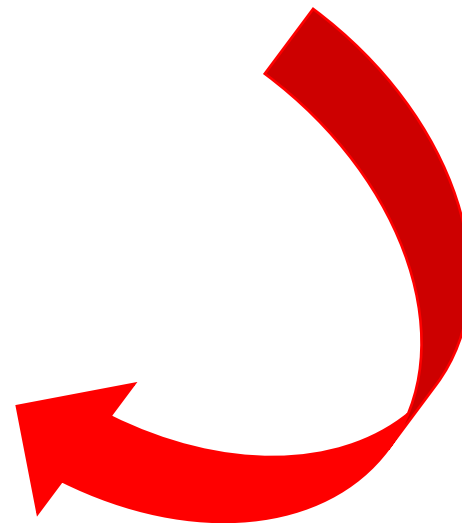
