You designate the State or National Forest where the trees will be planted

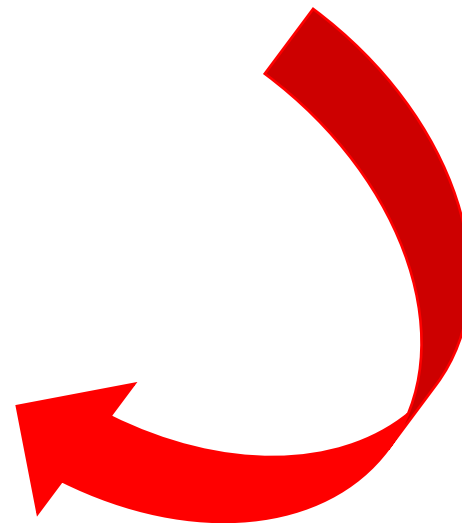
Littleton Garden Club will provide forms and submit your donations
